Offenbach's *Orpheus in the Underworld* is always an audience favorite. Amy Foote will charm in her Pocket debut as Eurydice, with Andrew Metzger as Pluto, and Nathanael Fleming debuting as Orpheus. You'll be doing the can-can in your seats!

Last up is our co-production with Cinnabar Theater. Every year, this collaboration allows us to stretch our budget, and continue to bring in the very best talent. This year's offering is Puccini's *Tosca*, which Pocket hasn't produced in over two decades. Michelle Drever, whom Pocket Opera audiences will remember from her three standing ovations as Violetta in *La Traviata*, returns as the doomed soprano, Floria Tosca. Making his Pocket Opera debut will be Alex Boyer as Cavaradossi. Sure to be a season highlight, *Tosca* will be directed by Elly Lichenstein with Mary Chun conducting. 2023 will truly be a season of sparkling song and daring drama.

We have completed filming of the live-action sequences and are nearly halfway through the animation process. Our youth orchestra is rehearsing for their recording of the score in February, and our team is hard at work on the study guides that will accompany this educational program. Set in Africa, this retelling of Mozart's masterpiece features an all-Black cast, and a predominantly Black (and largely female) creative team.


