

Next, we present The Merry Wives of Windsor—a brilliant opera that you will likely only find at Pocket Opera. Our inaugural Reznikoff Artist Rena Harms, playing Mrs. Ford, has sung major roles internationally, most notably at English National Opera; she is joined by our **Hurst Artist**, Kenneth Kellogg, renowned bass seen at San Francisco Opera and LA Opera, among others. Musical Director Robby Stafford brings fresh talent to his first Pocket Opera production.

And what better way to end the year than with another Puccini hit presented with our co-producers at Cinnabar Theater? Join us for La Bohème, starring Pocket's 2024 Greenberg Artist, Nicholas Huff as Rodolfo, and Pocket newcomer Diana Skavronskaya as Mimi. Heartbreak never sounded this beautiful!
